HIS RESEARCH INTERESTS INCLUDE THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN MENTAL DISORDER AND CRIMINAL BEHAVIOUR, STALKING, THE LONG TERM IMPACT OF CHILDHOOD SEXUAL ABUSE, JEALOUSY, AND LITIGIOUS AND CHRONIC COMPLAINERS. HE HAS PUBLISHED WIDELY, CO-AUTHORED THREE BOOKS AND CONTRIBUTED OVER 40 CHAPTERS IN OTHERS INCLUDING THE TWO STANDARD BRITISH TEXTBOOKS ON FORENSIC PSYCHIATRY.

HE IS CURRENTLY INVOLVED IN TREATMENT TRIALS OF BOTH MEDICATION AND COGNITIVE REMEDIATION OF PERSISTENT COGNITIVE DEFICITS IN SCHIZOPHRENIA.

THIS INVOLVES THE STUDY OF HOW HUMANS SHAPE TIME EXPRESSIVELY AND COMMUNICATIVELY USING GESTURAL NARRATIVES OF VOICE AND BODY. HE IS CURRENTLY CO-EDITING A BOOK ON COMMUNICATIVE MUSICALITY WHICH WILL BE PUBLISHED BY OXFORD UNIVERSITY PRESS.
