**PROFESSOR PAUL MULLEN** IS PROFESSOR OF FORENSIC PSYCHIATRY AT MONASH UNIVERSITY, AND CLINICAL DIRECTOR, VICTORIAN INSTITUTE OF FORENSIC MENTAL HEALTH. HIS RESEARCH INTERESTS INCLUDE THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN MENTAL DISORDER AND CRIMINAL BEHAVIOUR, STALKING, THE LONG TERM IMPACT OF CHILDHOOD SEXUAL ABUSE, JEALOUSY, AND LITIGIOUS AND CHRONIC COMPLAINERS. HE HAS PUBLISHED WIDELY, CO-AUTHORED THREE BOOKS AND CONTRIBUTED OVER 40 CHAPTERS IN OTHERS INCLUDING THE TWO STANDARD BRITISH TEXTBOOKS ON FORENSIC PSYCHIATRY.



**DR MARK MONTEBELLO** IS A STAFF SPECIALIST IN PSYCHIATRY AT THE LANGTON CENTRE IN SURRY HILLS, AND A VMO AT THE SYDNEY CLINIC IN BRONTE. HER RESEARCH AND TEACHING INTERESTS INCLUDE INTEGRATING WESTERN PSYCHOLOGY AND EASTERN PHILOSOPHIES AND SHE HAS CONDUCTED WORKSHOPS ON THE USE OF MEDITATION IN PSYCHOTHERAPY BOTH HERE AND OVERSEAS.



**PROFESSOR NAGESH BRAHMAVAR PAI** IS CURRENTLY THE SENIOR STAFF SPECIALIST PSYCHIATRIST/SECTOR DIRECTOR AT THE SHELLHARBOUR HOSPITAL IN NSW. HE WAS ON THE FACULTY OF PSYCHIATRY AT A MEDICAL UNIVERSITY IN INDIA FOR OVER 13 YEARS INCLUDING OCCUPYING THE CHAIR OF PROFESSOR & HEAD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHIATRY FOR 5 YEARS. HE HAS BEEN THE PRINCIPAL INVESTIGATOR FOR OVER 30 MULTICENTRIC INTERNATIONAL PSYCHOPHARMACOLOGICAL TRIALS AND WAS ON THE EDITORIAL COMMITTEE & REVIEWER BOARD OF A NUMBER OF INDIAN JOURNALS.



**DR ANTHONY HARRIS** IS THE DIRECTOR OF THE CLINICAL DISORDERS UNIT AT THE BRAIN DYNAMICS CENTRE, WESTMEAD HOSPITAL. HIS PRINCIPLE RESEARCH INTERESTS CENTRE ON THE PSYCHOPHYSIOLOGY, NEUROIMAGING AND TREATMENT OF PSYCHOSIS AND SCHIZOPHRENIA. THIS WORK HAS INCLUDED ESTABLISHING A LARGE DATABASE IN THE PSYCHOPHYSIOLOGY OF PEOPLE WITH PSYCHOSIS AND FUNCTIONAL MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING RESEARCH INTO THE PERCEPTION OF FACIAL EMOTION IN SCHIZOPHRENIA. HE IS CURRENTLY INVOLVED IN TREATMENT TRIALS OF BOTH MEDICATION AND COGNITIVE REMEDIATION OF PERSISTENT COGNITIVE DEFICITS IN SCHIZOPHRENIA.



**DR STEPHEN MALLOCH** TRAINED IN PERFORMANCE AND MUSICOLOGY AT THE SYDNEY CONSERVATORIUM OF MUSIC. HE WAS A RESEARCH FELLOW AT THE UNIVERSITY OF EDINBURGH, AND IS NOW AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WESTERN SYDNEY. HIS RESEARCH HAS CONCENTRATED ON WHAT HE CALLS THE COMMUNICATIVE MUSICALITY OF HUMAN NON-LINGUISTIC INTERACTION. THIS INVOLVES THE STUDY OF HOW HUMANS SHAPE TIME EXPRESSIVELY AND COMMUNICATIVELY USING GESTURAL NARRATIVES OF VOICE AND BODY. HE IS CURRENTLY CO-EDITING A BOOK ON COMMUNICATIVE MUSICALITY WHICH WILL BE PUBLISHED BY OXFORD UNIVERSITY PRESS.
